

Definition of Supportive Medicines (Ref 2014 Commissioning Intentions)

Only those drugs which are defined as a priority within a recognised chemotherapy regimen will be funded as part of the pass through arrangements. It does not include drugs which are provided for symptoms that arise post chemotherapy (e.g. antiemetics, unless given to all patients as part of the standard regimen) and it does not include longer-term use of non-chemotherapeutic agents such as bisphosphonates. In addition, hormone therapies, unless specifically identified as excluded by the national Payment by Results team or by agreement with NHS England, are considered in tariff.
