Reappointment of Professor Bee Wee as National Clinical Director who will take work forward in 2016-17, an End of Life Care programme with three overarching work streams:


- **Enhancing physical and mental well-being of the individual**

This guide aims to ensure that people benefit from good social work at the end of their life, and that those close to them are supported during this time and into bereavement.




