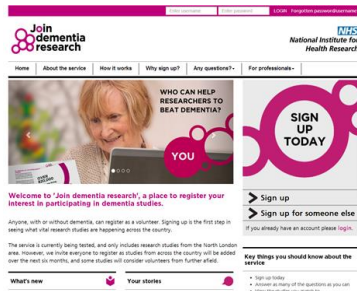

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Why is it useful?

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So what are the benefits of signing up?

-  **Find** studies matching patients' information
-  **Connect** with researchers and expressing an interest in their studies

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What kind of studies?

...from **clinical trials of new treatments to surveys** identifying what works in improving the quality of life for people with dementia.



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Who can help dementia research?

- Anyone **with** and **without** dementia over the age of 18 can register and people can [register on behalf of someone else](#).
- You do not have to take part in any studies. It is always **your choice** to take part or not.



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How do patients sign up?

- ❑ It takes **5-10** minutes to sign up.
- ❑ Volunteers just need to provide some **demographic and health information** which will enable the service to match them to suitable studies.
