Where are we?

- Local Action plan presented to Cornwall Health and Well-Being Board as part of Mental Health presentation delivered by Public Health, Cornwall Partnership NHS Foundation Trust & CCG
- Local implementation group formally ratified by HWBB in May
- HWBB appoints 'Advocate' for Crisis Care Concordat and agrees oversight role
- IOS HWBB discussion 30th June 2015

Priority Areas 1

- Acute pathway- review commissioned from an Independent Consultant. Review will include HTT, Community Interface, Alternatives to admission, Benchmarking and bed base. (Increased activity in Out of County acute MH placements).
- Piloting Mental Health support in Urgent Care Centre- MH Trust led
- Reviewing specification for IAPT services with Stakeholders

Priority areas continued

Kernow Clinical Commissioning Group

- Discussions with Royal Cornwall Hospitals Trust regarding additional all age Place of Safety
- 4 hour waits in ED –MH response to achieve Parity of Esteem

Signs of Success 1

- HWBBs engaged with MH agenda
- MH Training programme for Police Officers in delivery phase
- Reduction in s136 activity
- MH interwoven with Living Well Pioneer programme
- Liaison & Diversion service- early identification and intervention

Signs of Success 2

- MH cohort identified as part of Integrated Personalised Commissioning work stream-targeted at Repeat Attenders at RCH; this includes Voluntary Sector and housing.

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
