Diabetes in Healthcare is an introductory course for healthcare professionals who are not specialists in diabetes but want to know more about the condition.

Diabetes on the net gives access to a suite of modules which can form part of CPD. Many of the modules have been developed by the Primary Care Diabetes Society in association with TREND-UK.

There is also a series of 6 interactive mini-modules, each focusing on a different challenge in diabetes management, and highlighting how time and resources can be optimised whilst providing individualised care. Titles include:

- Insulin – prescribing it effectively and safely
- Optimising oral therapy
- Neuropathy in diabetes – practical tips on screening, management and referral
- Diabetes crises – what needs immediate referral and what can be actioned in practice?
- Diagnostic dilemmas – what the primary care team needs to know
- NICE targets – blood pressure, cholesterol and HbA1c
